Location:	Shenfield common. Madeira Walk
Parking:	Limited parking on verge opposite cornland or King Georges Park
Scheduled Works:	General tidy of Woodland Pond areas and Madeira walk. litter pick site
Date:	10 th May 2023
Location:	Hatch road country park
Parking:	Bishops' hall park
Scheduled Works:	Clearance of debris from streamlines. Litter collection remove weed growth from around community orchard, and park seating. Tidy bridge crossing points from Marconi gardens. Litter pick site.
Date:	17 th May 2023
Location:	La plata grove woodland
Parking:	Limited parking on the open space at the end of Wharf Road
Scheduled Works:	Ensure ditch lines are running and are free from debris, Cut vegetation from cycle ways, litter pick site.
Date:	24 th May 2023
Location:	St Faiths country park
Parking:	Limited parking at London road cemetery.
Scheduled Works:	Scrub clearance along field hedge lines, cut vegetation away from new trees. Alan Marsh will be on site
